Key Benefits of Honors Programs. Students in honors programs are given top priority in: orientation, housing, access to all faculty, major and career advisement, class selection, class scheduling. merit scholarships and other financial aid, research, internships, study abroad, graduate school advisement and professional school advisement. Colleges with "No Honors Program" typically provide honors-type services to all students. To be admitted to an Honors Program, (Step Two below), you must first be admitted to the college (Step One below).
