**COLLEGE APPLICATIONS.** Seniors should submit on-line or paper applications, application fees, transcripts, recommendations and copies of their resume (optional) to their top choice colleges by **October 15**, regardless of SAT or ACT status. All other college applications should be submitted before December 31. **Note: Colleges give equal weight to the SAT and ACT tests for admission and scholarship purposes, so a student's best score is used, regardless if it is the ACT or SAT. Therefore, students are urged to take both tests.**
